1. Entries are limited to three (3) per individual, included on one submission form.
2. Each piece must be labeled with your name, telephone number and corresponding title.
3. All submissions must be accompanied by a completed entry form. Artworks and forms are to be dropped off to MSVU Art Gallery during the submission period (see reverse for dates).
4. All wall-mounted pieces must be ready to hang (i.e. with a wire, or other attachment). If you would like guidance on how to do this, please contact David Dahms (info below) before submitting your work.
5. Complex or large pieces require consultation with David Dahms before they are submitted.
6. Small objects may be exhibited in secure cases; please contact David Dahms to request this.
7. Pieces requiring media equipment (e.g. projectors, audio players, TV monitor) will be accepted based on equipment availability.
8. Performances must be scheduled in advance; please contact Traci Steylen (info below) to discuss options.
9. You are welcome to invite friends and family to the opening reception (see reverse for date).
10. You will be added to our email list.
