- 2. Each piece must be labeled with your name, telephone number, and corresponding title.
- 3. All submissions must be accompanied by a completed entry form. Artworks and forms are to be dropped off to MSVU Art Gallery during the submission period (December 1 to December 5, 930am to 4:00pm).
- 4. All artwork must be ready to display.
- 5. If your work is large, has specific or complex installation needs, or requires media (tvs/projectors/audio components, etc.), you must contact Gallery staff prior to drop-off for a consultation.
- 6. Performances must be scheduled in advance; please contact Gallery staff (info below) to discuss options.
- 7. You are welcome to invite friends and family to the opening on Thursday, December 11 at 12:00 noon.

- Late submissions may not be accepted.
- Your work will be handled and installed professionally and with care, and the Gallery is staffed during opening hours. However, we cannot accept responsibility for any losses or damage to artwork.
- The Gallery is not responsible for storage of artwork after pick up period (January 19 to 23, 2026).
- Smudging is permitted in the Gallery and may take place during the exhibition period. If you have questions about smudging, please contact Gallery staff.
